

Assembly Guide

LIPS

To detach the parts from the board, press the anchor point with your thumb.

Always push with your thumb on the engraved side of the board, so the piece falls under the board.

You can easily locate the anchors points by looking at the back of the board.

Use PVA glue diluted with a little water. (3 parts adhesive, 1 part of water).

Use a small file to remove the anchor points' residues. You can also use a modeler's knife (handle it carefully to prevent injury).

Use a small brush to spread the diluted glue.



Guide - Fountain



These two parts form the center of the fountain.



Slide them into one another and glue them.



Insert the smallest round part on to the central cross-shaped support.

Push it to the maximum.



Add and glue the mid-sized round part.



Add and glue the large round underneath.



Grab the base and glue the assemblage in the center. By following these steps, it allows you to have a perfectly centered fountain.



Grab these two circles, glue the narrowest one to the wider one, on their flat sides. Make sure they are properly centered before the glue dries out.





Center the two circles over the center on the base.



Finally, you have four heads, glue them on the supports leaving some of the latter exceed.



All that is left is to paint it.
