



Assembly Guide

TIPS

To detach the parts from the board, press the anchor point with your thumb.
 Always push with your thumb on the engraved side of the board, so the piece falls under the board.
 You can easily locate the anchors points by looking at the back of the board.
 Use PVA glue diluted with a little water. (3 parts adhesive, 1 part of water).
 Use a small file to remove the anchor points' residues. You can also use a modeler's knife (handle it carefully to prevent injury).
 Use a small brush to spread the diluted glue.



Guide Townhouse 3rd Floor

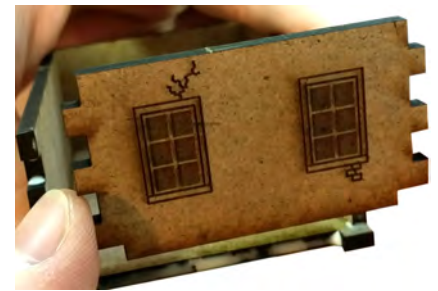
For each house, you will have the same parts with the same numbers. The only difference are the windows



Take the parts [2] and [6].
 Position part [6] at one end of part [2]



Add two parts [5] to form the sides



Add part [7] at the end of the
 two parts [5] to close the story



Position one part [12] on each corner of [2]
 under the floor while making sure that the
 parts [12] do not encroach on the walls



Shutters

Glue the shutters to either side of the windows while selecting the appropriate shutters for each window type.
 For **model A**: The angled shutters go on the windows with the angled top and the shorter sides go against the windows.
 For **model B**: you only have rounded shutters and the shorter sides go against the window.
 For **model C**: the shutters are all identical and rectangular. Glue them against the windows

Match each story with its corresponding house. To do this, rely on the style of the windows.
