



# Assembly Guide

## TIPS

To detach the parts from the board, press the anchor point with your thumb.  
 Always push with your thumb on the engraved side of the board, so the piece falls under the board.  
 You can easily locate the anchors points by looking at the back of the board.  
 Use PVA glue diluted with a little water. (3 parts adhesive, 1 part of water).  
 Use a small file to remove the anchor points' residues. You can also use a modeler's knife (handle it carefully to prevent injury).  
 Use a small brush to spread the diluted glue.



## Guide Corner Shop

### 1st Floor



Glue [F] and [E] together and then into part [A].



Glue [C] and [D] together. Glue them on [A] across from [F] and [E].



Glue two parts [K] to complete the story.

### 2nd Floor



Glue [M] and [L] together and then insert them onto a part [H].



Glue [I] and [J] together and insert them to the back of [H]. Complete the story with 2 parts [K].

### 3rd Floor



Follow the same steps as for the 2nd floor, but use [M1] and [L1] instead of [M] and [L].

### Roof



We recommend assembling [O, N, P, R, S, T] and the last [H] part without glue the first time, just so you see how it all fits together. This will help you avoid making mistakes.

Glue five [Y] under each floor except the first floor. Leave a little more than 3mm between the edges of the walls and the [Y] parts to make sure the floors fit on each other. Try them before letting the glue dry out.

The staircase exits on the roofs consist of [U, X, V, and W]. Once assembled, glue them to apposition of your choosing. You can use one, or both.



## Cardboard



Cut the anchor points with a modeling knife and be careful not to injure yourself or damage your parts.



Start with the columns [3]. Handle them carefully, they are fragile.

Glue each column, slightly overlapping the guide line on each side of the windows.

Make sure that your glue is sufficiently diluted and that you spread it well to the four corners of the column and its entire surface. Try not to be too generous.



Glue and center the parts [2] so they overhang over the 4 columns.



Glue parts [1] as to cover each part [2], tightly fitted at the top. They give extra texture and detail to the model.



All that remains is positioning the placards of your choosing.

Take the two identical placards, and stick them back to back and insert them into the slot at the front of the 2nd floor.
