



Assembly Guide

TIPS

- To detach the parts from the board, press the anchor point with your thumb.
- Always push with your thumb on the engraved side of the board, so the piece falls under the board.
- You can easily locate the anchors points by looking at the back of the board.
- Use PVA glue diluted with a little water. (3 parts adhesive, 1 part of water).
- Use a small file to remove the anchor points' residues. You can also use a modeler's knife (handle it carefully to prevent injury).
- Use a small brush to spread the diluted glue.



Guide Wooden Bridge



Center all four [R] over [V]. Be delicate with parts [R], because they are fragile and can easily break



Align both parts [T] to complete the base of the model



Position part [A] at either end to start building the bridge's floor structure. Continue the assemblage ordering the parts alphabetically finishing with [N]. Be careful to properly align all parts in the same direction as seen on the board.



Glue the parts [W] into the holes provided for this purpose along the floor. By holding your model on its side, you ensure the parts [W] will dry aligned with each other



To finish, glue two parts [U] into the openings seen on all parts [W].



Glue parts [O] in pairs,
keeping the engraved sides visible



Glue parts [P] and [Q] on each side of the feet



You can position the feet wherever you want. It only depends on the look you want to give to the bridge. Note that the closer you place your feet to the end of the bridge, the higher it will be and up to a point where your model will not touch the surface of your table.

We added some extra squares [S] that you can slide under the feet if you wish to make a diorama with a river that is hollower.
