
## Advice

Before spreading glue on a piece, it is always wise to test it. Make sure that the piece fits well in its location and that the result corresponds to the photos. If the piece does not fit, do not hesitate to sand the portion that causes difficulties to thin it.



Glue the long columns as shown in the photo on the left, make sure to push them up as much as possible to make sure they don't stick out at the bottom. And do the same with the shorter columns as shown in the photo on the right. It's two pieces fit into the walls on the etched side.





Join the two largest walls with the floor in an "L" shape. It is best to start by gluing the flooring to the largest wall and add the smaller wall later.





Glue your assembly to the large rectangular floor and the second "L" shaped floor on top of your walls.





Gather all the interior columns as shown in the photos on the left. The interior columns are intended to hide the places where the exterior columns are inserted. You have three lengths of columns, the longest go to the top floor. Take care to glue them in the right direction since they are beveled on one of the two ends. The shortest columns (in the center of the photo) are glued to the middle floor and the right columns (those which are 7.5cm) go to the lowest floor.
